Columbia Police Department is hosting a Basic Criminal Investigations course from November 7th, 2016 through November 11th, 2016. This is a forty (40) hour course that is designed for investigators and experienced patrol officers to become familiar with the basic general aspects of criminal investigations. This course also includes TN P.O.S.T. mandatory in-service training topics of Child Sexual Abuse, Mental Health and Emergency Vehicle Operations Course (lecture only).

Class times will be from 8 a.m. each morning to 5 p.m. each afternoon. One hour lunch break and, at minimum, two intermediate breaks will be given each day.

Class dress code will be business casual or uniform. On Friday, November 11th, participants will be performing hands on exercises with fingerprint powders and other crime scene supplies. Dress on that day should be relaxed with clothing that participants will not mind getting dirty.

Participants will be required to participate in group classroom activities, pass a sixty-five (65) question written test, and successfully complete practical examinations for evidence collection.

Seating is limited. Participants should register prior to October 24th, 2016 for consideration. Confirmation notices will be sent on or after October 26th, 2016
